Requirements

This community service scholarship is open to students whose lives have been affected by ALS and who have demonstrated strength of character through volunteering and community service.

- a. Must have a direct ALS connection
- b. Can be a private, middle, or high school student
- Can be a high school graduate attending an accredited 2 or 4-year university, trade school program, or similar
- d. Must complete applicant information form
- e. Must submit proof of higher education acceptance, transcript or current enrollment in a private school
- f. Must submit an essay (Please see requirements listed above)
