## Essay


- b. Must be 500 to 1000 words
- c. Must detail how ALS has affected you
- d. Must also detail how you have helped others

**Tip:** Share volunteer service, caregiving for loved ones, fundraising etc.

## Requirements

This community service scholarship is open to students whose lives have been affected by ALS and who have led an unselfish life through volunteering and community service.

- a. Must have a direct ALS connection
- b. Must be a high school graduate attending an accredited 2- or 4-year university, trade school program, or similar
- c. Must complete applicant information form
- d. Must submit proof of higher education acceptance, transcript or current enrollment in a private school
- e. Must submit an essay (Please see requirements listed above)
