
Volunteer Uniforms

RADIO ETIQUETTE:

1. Speak clearly & slowly.
2. Hold button for 2 seconds prior to speaking.
3. Keep radio speaker 2-3 inches away from your face when communicating.
4. Do not swear on radio.
5. Do not share any sensitive information over the radio.
6. In the case of a medical emergency, please remain calm. Do not yell over the radio. Speak clearly and slowly.
 - a. Please radio for First Aid on the First Aid Channel, with the location, type of the medical emergency and any other information you feel is important. Please pause to let them response. Please stay on the channel with First Aid until First Aid arrives at medical issue.
 - b. Once First Aid has arrived at the medical emergency, please contact Tournament Staff (channel 2)- notifying that First Aid is onsite, the location of the emergency and any additional information you feel is important. Please pause for our response.
7. Try to limit pinching the radio or sitting on the button to allow open communication.
8. Check your radio in and out daily in Volunteer HQ.
9. Please return headset and radio together.
10. Ensure your radio is charged.
11. Please return radios each day. Missing radios may be subject to a replacement fee


Take I-75 South to Exit 111- Immokalee Road



EVACUATION & INCLEMENT WEATHER PLAN



HAZARDOUS WEATHER/EVACUATION PLAN

The Champion's Tour will suspend play with a blast from air horns positioned around the course. In the event of play being suspended due to a dangerous situation, such as lightning, all players must cease play immediately and assemble at the locations outlined:

A – Walk to staged shuttle carts on player right of 17 Fwy – (2) 6 passenger carts

C – Walk to staged shuttle carts on 5 Tee, players left (2) 6 passenger carts

D – Walk to staged shuttle carts at 8 Green, players left (2) 6 passenger carts

***At the appropriate time Player/Caddies/Volunteers who require transportation back on the course should assemble in front of the clubhouse. Carts or vans will be stationed there with hole numbers and/or areas specified.**

Admissions / Will Call

The Admissions/Will Call Tent will be right near the 1st tee of the Black Course.

Attitude

You are representing the entire Tournament as a volunteer. Any time you are in uniform, there will be players and other VIP's assuming you are on duty. Please help us make all guests feel welcome, answer questions, and help those in need.

Autograph Policy

To enhance the autograph experience for all spectators, while allowing players to properly prepare for competition, the PGA TOUR has established the following guidelines:

- Autographs can only be obtained in designated Autograph Zones
- On-course autographs are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to tees, fairways, greens, and practice areas during practice rounds and tournament rounds

Badge Information

Volunteers will receive one badge for the week. This badge should always be visible. This badge will serve as your ticket onto the tournament grounds and your parking pass. Volunteer credentials will allow general access to tournament grounds on days not scheduled to work.

Buses

Buses transporting volunteers to the course will operate from approximately 5:30am to 6:30pm during tournament week (PLEASE NOTE: shuttles will run only on Monday, February 9th through Sunday, February 15th). Shuttle buses will run continuous loops from the volunteer parking lot to the main drop off point at Tiburón.

Carts & Radios

Volunteers will have limited access to carts, and only those volunteers (including chairpersons) on a list released by the Tournament will be permitted to use a cart. Any volunteer using a cart and/or radio should use caution to avoid interfering with golf in any manner. Utilization of the cart should be held to a bare minimum during play; avoid using routes adjacent to golfers. Chairpersons needing carts will check out their carts from the Carts & Shuttles Chairmen at the Cart Barn located near the Volunteer HQ. Chairpersons and Hole Captains checking out radios will pick up their radios at the Volunteer HQ.

Committee Check-In

All volunteers will check-in with their respective Chairperson, unless instructed otherwise by your Chairperson. If you are a marshal, you will check in with your Hole Captain. Some committees will have their own check-in desks in the Volunteer Headquarters to distribute daily assignments. After verifying attendance, volunteers are then asked to report to their chairperson and/or assignment. We recommend arriving at Volunteer Headquarters 30-45 minutes before your assigned shift.

Emergencies

For medical assistance, please notify a marshal, walking scorer, PGA TOUR staff member or Tournament personnel on the hole closest to you. A marshal will have a radio on each hole. Please inform the marshal of the emergency. In the case of an emergency, use the following procedures:

Survey the scene (check for potential danger).

- DO NOT move the person. Make the person as comfortable as possible without moving him/her.
 - Contact the nearest marshal, walking scorer, PGA TOUR staff member or Tournament personnel with a radio so he/she can notify First Aid. Give the exact location of the emergency (e.g. player's left on the 18th green).
- Stay at the scene until the emergency personnel arrive.
- Provide background of medical problem or emergency if possible.

First Aid

First Aid is located near the Fitness Center lawn. Please make yourself aware of the First Aid location before your first shift.

Food and Beverage

Your volunteer credential is also good for food and drink from the meal pickup in Volunteer Headquarters, on days you work. If you are a marshal working an ALL DAY shift, your lunch will be delivered to you during your shift time. Food is only available to volunteers who are working on that day!

Lost and Found

Lost and Found will be located at the Volunteer Headquarters.

Merchandise

Merchandise will be available in the Tiburón Golf Club Pro Shop.

Mobile Device Policy

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Mobile Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use.
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas.
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media.
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket.

Personal Possessions and Storage

There are NO storage locations for personal items. Please do not bring valuable items you cannot wear. Small bags and purses are permitted. Do not leave personal belongings in the Volunteer Headquarters. Any items left behind will be delivered to lost and found located in the Volunteer Headquarters.

Prohibited Items

The following items are prohibited during tournament week. All items subject to search. Any unauthorized items found on tournament grounds will be confiscated.

- Cameras and Video Cameras
- Radios, TVs, Signs, Banners, Clipboards
- Beverages or Coolers (including water, coffee, soda, etc.)
- Firearms, Explosives, or weapons of any kind
- Large backpacks and other large carry items (drawstring bags are allowed)
- Cellular phones are permitted, but must be turned off or silenced
- No oversize chairs/lawn chairs without a cover (golf stools and folding camping chairs are permitted)
- Pets (other than service animals)
- Aerosol cans and bottles
- Noise producing devices and laser pointer devices
- Laptops/Computers
- Glass cups or bottle except for medical or infant use
- Drones, remote controlled aircrafts, or other devices that can be operated in airspace

Report Times

Each volunteer should check-in as instructed by his/her chairperson approximately 30-45 minutes before the shift begins. Please check your shift times on Trust Event or with your Chairperson prior to coming. Be sure to leave adequate time for parking, eating, riding the shuttle and reporting for your assignment. Restrooms

Restrooms will be located throughout the Tournament grounds and near the Volunteer Headquarters. Please refer to the Course Map on page #5

Tobacco and Alcohol

For the safety of everyone involved, volunteers are NOT allowed to consume alcoholic beverages prior to or during their work shifts. We also ask that volunteers do not smoke while on duty or inside the ropes.

Volunteer Headquarters

Volunteer Headquarters is located in the Tiburón Clubhouse Parking Lot.

Volunteer Uniform

All volunteers must wear their volunteer shirt while working for the 2026 Chubb Classic presented by SERVPRO. Volunteers are asked to wear solid-colored shorts, skirts or pants of an appropriate length and comfortable walking shoes (golf shoes NOT suggested). Please remember to bring sunscreen or proper rain gear if needed.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Please remember sunscreen and rain gear if needed
- Grab small snacks from Volunteer HQ and water
- Display your credentials at all times
- Drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration
- Familiarize yourself with the First Aid Tent and restroom locations around the course
- Wear headgear for protection from the sun and use sunscreen
- Please be on time for your shift. We recommend arriving at the Volunteer Parking Lot 30 - 45 minutes prior to your shift to allow time to park, ride the shuttle, eat and report for duty.
- Keep your cell phone on silent or vibrate.
