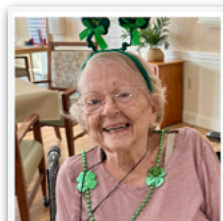

There's Charlie, let's pause

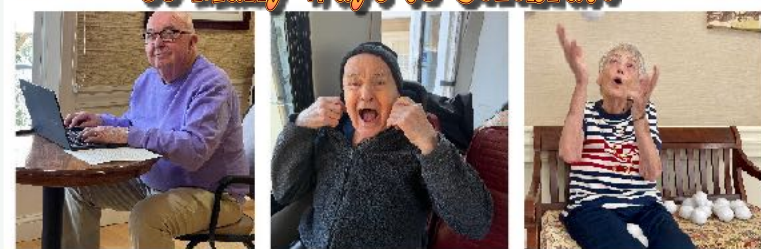


When tulips are in bloom

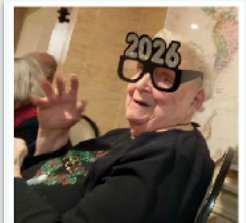


Tiny bubbles, in the air. Makes us feel happy... even if landing on our hair.

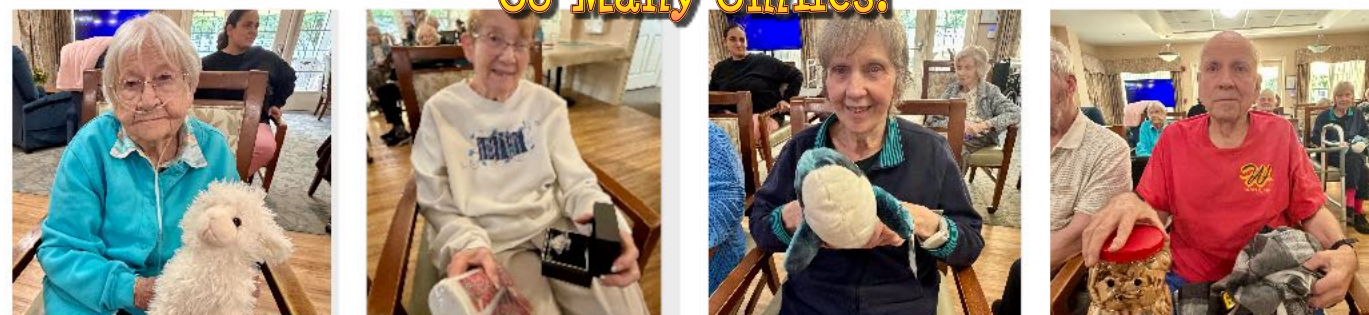
